	<p>FSC Mixed Sources Products that come from FSC's certified well managed forests, company controlled sources and/or recycled material. 	<p>PEFC: Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification</p> <p>The Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) is an international non-profit, non-governmental organization dedicated to promoting Sustainable Forest Management (SFM) through independent third-party certification. 	<p>Recyclable</p> <p>This symbol means that the product is made from materials that can be recycled. It does not necessarily mean that the product was produced from recycled</p>
	<p>Recycle Content</p> <p>This symbol means that the product was made from material that has been used before.</p>
